Piazza Dining Center

The award-winning University of Northern Iowa all-you-care-to-eat dining center—Piazza is open for lunch on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday and dinner on Thursday and Friday. Piazza is within walking distance from the Dome and McLeod (a less than 600 ft walk).

Pre-order dining cards by March 8, 2026 for special team pricing of \$10.50/card (regularly \$12.00/card).

Teams will order cards by meal and be issued individual dining cards for each meal ordered Each card is valid for 1 lunch or dinner on any of the FIRST Regional dates (March 26, 27, or 28). This will allow teams to distribute their cards to team members as needed and allow teams to eat in shifts around the competition activities, as necessary. Each team's packet of cards will also include a return envelope Teams that return unused cards in the envelope at lunch on Saturday, March 29 (or at their last meal in Piazza) will be reimbursed for the unused cards. Teams are responsible for returning cards on time if they want a reimbursement.

Tickets purchased after March 8 and on site are billed at the regular rate of\$12.00/person (ages 11 and up). Walk-ins are also welcome at the normal rate of\$12.00—Piazza Dining Center accepts credit/debit cards only —NO CASH. Pre-ordering saves money and time waiting in line!

All youth team participants must be chaperoned by an adult when in the dining center

Piazza Hours

Lunch is served from 11 am to 1:30 pm. On Thursday and Friday ONLY, Lite Lunch is also served from 1:30 pm to 5:00 pm. Lite lunch has fewer offerings than Lunch but will still always have multiple options. Dining cards may be used during lunch or lite lunch.

Piazza is also open during dinner hours (5:00 pm-7:00pm with Lite Dinner served until 9:00 pm) on Thursday and Friday. Dinner tickets may also be pre-purchased through the team order form.
